Objectives

- Identification of the territorial incidence of Risk Factors regarding the major natural, technological and environmental hazards in Portugal;
- Identification of the triggering and determinant factors of hazardous processes and actions with territorial consequences;

- Acquisition of methods and techniques for assessing the vulnerability and value of the exposed elements;
- Implementation of risk analysis procedures within the scope of land management.
